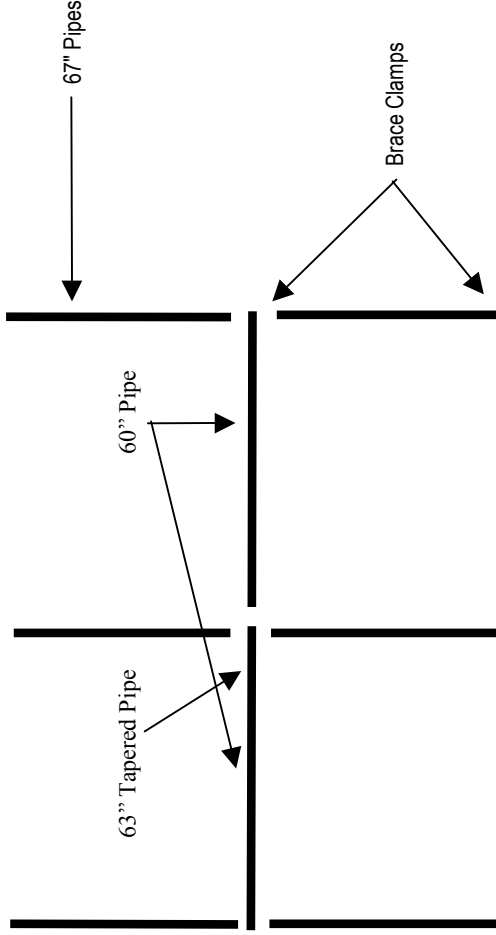

**PLEASE INVENTORY ALL PARTS**

60" Pipe	1
67" Pipe	6
63" (taper - one end)	1
12' x 10' Tarp	1
Ball Bungees	16
Brace Clamps (2-pc sets)	12
Pipe caps	12

**SAFETY PRECAUTIONS**

- Do not erect this structure in windy conditions.
- We recommend anchoring the kennel securely to ground.
- Remove tarp or take down canopy during adverse weather conditions to prevent damage to your canopy.
- This product should be used accordingly. It may NOT withstand strong winds, snow loads or other adverse weather conditions.
- QuickCover recommends that you do NOT cook under the structure. The tarp will not flame, but could melt. Meets all requirements of commercial standards CS-192-53 (paragraph 4.10) for flammability.



- Step 1** - Inventory all parts: lay out on ground as illustrated.
- Step 2** - Assemble roof section: join 43" pipe to tapered pipe to form center rail as illustrated. Connect 67" pipes with brace clamps to center rail and top frame of kennel, forming a canopy-style frame.
- Step 3** - Once frame is assembled, place tarp over frame. Fasten corners of tarp to frame with bungees. Bungees are attached by pushing the elastic through the tarp grommet from the top, wrapping it around pipe or mesh and then around bungee ball.
- Step 4** - Install anchors (recommended). Anchor/stake kits are available at your local retailers or by calling at the number below.
